

WINDOWS 7

Copia has recently added print driver support for both Windows 7 and Windows Server 2008 R2. This allows these operating systems to be used for the CopiaFacts Client software, Document Converters, and Copia's patented FFMERGE driver. Both 32-bit and 64-bit versions are supported for Windows 7; Windows Server 2008 R2 is 64-bit only.

Copia will also introduce further features specific to Windows 7 in the next major release of CopiaFacts, version 8, which is scheduled for release in 2010 Q2. These features will be available to those in maintenance.
