

Last Chance for Loop Start and BRI TR114 Cards

Brooktrout has previously announced the End Of Life for the TR114 Loop Start and TR114 BRI products back in October of 2004. Customers that still utilize these cards should note that the last date Copia may place an order for them is June 30th. Copia has also been informed of a current backlog delay in obtaining these cards of approximately 3-5 weeks. If you anticipate a need for these cards please inform your sales rep immediately so an order can be placed.

Unless there is a specific need to use TR114 cards, Copia highly recommends moving to the new Brooktrout TR1034 Analog and BRI cards for new and upgraded systems.

Written Permission Exemption Set to Expire

The FCC's currently self-imposed extended stay of the EBR (Existing Business Relationship) exemption to the TCPA is set to expire on June 30, 2005. As of June 7th the current Senate bill, S. 714 - the 'Junk Fax Prevention Act of 2005', has been placed on Senate Legislative Calendar under General Orders (Calendar No. 120)



Senate Bill S. 714 creates a statutory exception from the general prohibition on sending unsolicited advertisements if the fax is sent based on an EBR and other conditions are met. This legislation is designed to permit legitimate businesses to do business with their established customers via fax and other persons with whom they have an established relationship without the burden of collecting prior written permission to send these recipients commercial faxes. Copia's faxing systems have always supported 24/7/365 opt-out capabilities and Copia has never and does not condone unsolicited fax advertising.

Please refer to the "Command-Line" section under Programs in your reference manual (FaxFacts On-Line Help from your FaxFacts program group, or FFREF.PDF in your FaxFacts server folder)

Some examples of these files include:

- CATDBF: Concatenates DBF log files
- DELETEOLDER: Deletes old FS files based on minutes, hours, days or years.
- FAXABLE: Determines if a TIFF file is faxable without conversion
- FFMPT: Converts between multi-page and single page TIFF/F files
- FTPUPLOAD: For upload files to a FTP site (for post-processing, etc)
